CONTENTS

The need to train experts in the field of application of Law who are fluent in the English language is given by the increasing relevance that this language has professionally in the different areas of the exercise of Law, both at the level of international trade and in the treatment of with foreign residents, especially due to the fact that English has become the new lingua franca. In order to be efficient and competitive, especially in certain tourist areas, this requires professionals to have sufficient knowledge of technical language (legal English) to be able to interpret documents written in that language and to be able to communicate with their non-national clients, as well as their fellow practitioners in other territories of the European Union. In addition to these linguistic skills, as an added value for the next edition, and given the incorporation of the Malaga's Bar Association in the direction of the course, new matters of special relevance in legal practice are integrated, as well as comparative law, which address the legal issues that legal professionals encounter most frequently, between Spanish law and different legal systems of the countries whose nationals visit or reside here to a greater extent. It should also be noted that this course is carried out with the collaboration of the General Council of the Judiciary, which contributes ten participants to the course. In short, this new approach, which seeks to specialize legal professionals who practice with foreign clients by providing them with comprehensive training that includes technical knowledge and substantive comparative law, makes of this a new and necessary course for legal practice in Spain España.
